SUMMER CENTRE

DETAILS

Our summer Junior centre, which is a private secondary school during the academic year, is very well situated and within walking distance of most of our homestays. The school is a large, modern facility with bright classrooms and equipped with all the necessary teaching/learning technology. In addition, there are outdoor sports pitches, a large indoor gymnasium, a computer room, arts and crafts studio, music room and cookery class. The school also offers free supervised internet access, staff and resource room, a canteen and a dedicated team of teaching and auxiliary staff.
